Beginner Strum Patterns



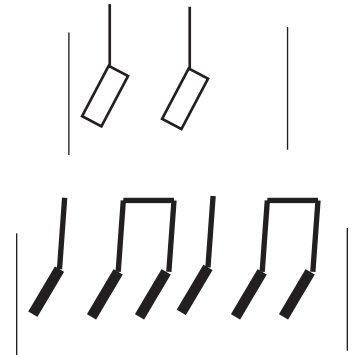
Good Night, Ladies
